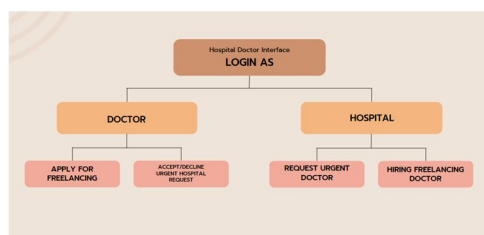
A. Synthesis/Algorithm/Design/Method

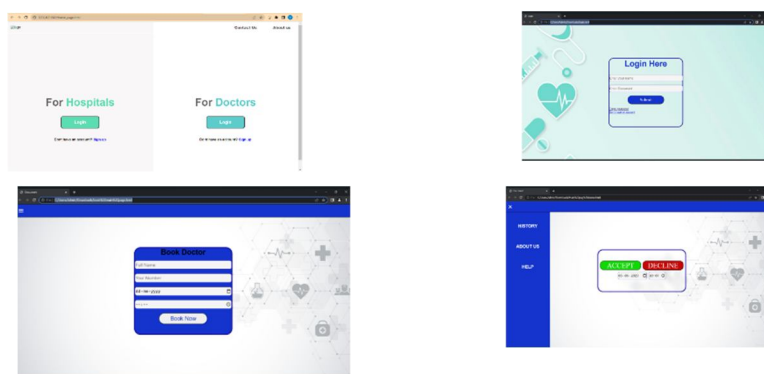
